

Naches Valley School District -- Two Levy Elections for February 9, 2010



Technology and Capital Projects Levy *

In addition, the school board will ask voters to consider a two year **combination Technology and Capital Projects levy.**

This new levy will:

- Improve access to technology for our students
- Pay the “local match” to a recently awarded \$175,520 State Energy Efficiency Grant to upgrade our heating and air conditioning systems
- Pay for an important group of building repairs and improvements
- Raise \$950,000 in each year 2011 and 2012.
- Cost taxpayers approximately \$1.26/thousand or \$15.75 a month for a \$150,000 house.
- Most importantly, move our **Facility Plan** forward.

These levy dollars will pay for repair and upgrades for technology, safety and crisis planning, HVAC/Mechanical/Energy, and Building Integrity and Use/Grounds. (Examples are below.)

Technology

Students' classroom/lab computers on a six year cycle

Teacher computers, projectors, document camera, shared printer, limited interactive screens

Network servers, switches, software, maintenance, TSS costs, training costs

Safety/Crisis Planning

Upgrade communication systems

Classroom locks (add internal controls)

Video systems

Broken furniture, ripped carpet, stair edge guards, crumbling sidewalks

HVAC/Mechanical/Energy

Air handling unit controls & repairs

Temper 'make up' air for Internal air quality, ventilation

Electrical system upgrades

HVAC Control upgrades

Insulation, window upgrades

Freezer unit upgrade

Building Integrity and Use/Grounds

Roofing repairs and replacement

Resurface HS Track

Parking lot surfacing, sidewalk improvements, sidewalk cover

Replace flooring where failed (carpet, tile, concrete)

Replace furniture where broken or unusable

Repair/replace bus lift to meet code
